

What to bring to camp:

- Sleeping bag/sheets, blanket, pillow
- Beach towel (used for pool)
- Bath towel & washcloths
- Personal toiletries – soap, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, comb, brush, etc.
- Clothing (enough for 4 days) underwear, socks, shorts, t-shirts, pants, sweatshirts & jacket, etc. (evenings can get cold) Bare midriffs, spaghetti straps or t-shirts with offensive language and pictures on them will NOT be allowed.
- Comfortable closed-toed shoes. (sandals may only be worn to and from the pool)
- One piece bathing suit for girls/ trunks for boys
- Flashlight (bring extra batteries)
- Any needed daily medication (medication must be given to the assigned nurse to dispense and Laurel Pines must have medical release form filled out)
- Bible, notebook & pen

Optional but highly recommended:

- Camera
- Sunscreen and chapstick
- Rain poncho/jacket
- Hat
- Money for Mt. Top Shop (snack bar)

What not to bring:

Radios, CD players, cell phones, iPods, Gameboys, etc. If these items are brought to camp they will be secured in the camp office during the week and returned to the camper the last day of camp.
